Last name, First name. Title. Place of publication: Publisher. Year.

Books with two authors

Last name, First, and First Last. Title. Place: Publisher. Year

Gillespie, Paula, and Neal Lerner. The Allyn and Bacon Guide. Boston: Allyn. 2000

Book with an editor

Peterson, Nancy, ed. Toni Morrison: Critical Approaches. Baltimore: Johns Hopkins. 1997

Article in a magazine or newspaper

Author. "Title of Article." *Title of Periodical*. Day Month Year: Page

Poniewozik, James. "TV Makes a Too-Close Call." *Time*. 20 Nov. 2000. 70-71

Website

Author. *Name of site*. Date of posting. Name of organization. Date you accessed the site. <electronic address>.
