



4th Grade School Supplies

Please note that all school supplies should be **CLEARLY LABELED** with your name (first & last) and grade...

- 7 colored pocket folders (with holes) labeled Religion, Math, Reading, Writing, Social Studies, Science, Spanish.
- 2" binder (no zipper binders, please)
- 1-1/2" hard cover binder with a pocket for music
- 1 set of alphabetical (a-z) binder dividers
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 500 sheets of **wide-ruled** binder paper (*please put 100 sheets in binder and replenish as needed*)
- 1 zipper case box for pens, pencils, etc.
- 3 **wide-ruled** binder paper notebooks **with perforated pages that tear out cleanly**
- 2 red pens for correcting work
- 3 doz. sharpened No. 2 pencils. (Please bring them all with you on the first day of school. The class will share these throughout the year.)
- 12" cm/in ruler (clear is best)
- 1 small bottle of white glue or 3 glue sticks
- 1 large pink pencil eraser
- **1 set** of 32 crayons
- **1 set** of water-based color markers in the 8 basic colors
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 1 Emergency kit: In a one-gallon zip lock bag, please include
 - 2 fruit cups
 - 2 pkgs. soup mix (powdered)
 - 2 granola bars OR trail mix in a small sealed container OR 2 packages of crackers
 - 1 bottle of water
 - 1 light stick (available at Dollar Tree)
 - 1 small container of hand sanitizer
 - 1 index card indicating child's name, home phone number, emergency contact, allergies, and any special directions.
