Please make sure that your supplies are clearly marked with your name and grade. Materials will need to be replenished throughout the year.

- ❑ 2 non-solid pocket folders for Spelling and Language Arts
- ❑ 1 1-1/2" hard cover binder with a pocket for music
- ❑ 500 sheets of Graph paper (.25" x .25") Available at Office Depot—you must ask for it.
- ❑ 1 set of alphabetical (a-z) binder dividers
- ❑ 1 dozen Black or Blue ballpoint pens for unit work
- ❑ 1 dozen Red ballpoint pens
- ❑ 1 multi-colored pen for Language Arts
- ❑ 1 dozen sharpened No. 2 Pencils
- ❑ 1000 sheets of wide ruled binder paper (allow a supply for each section and keep the rest at home)
- ❑ 12" ruler with inch, cm and mm markings
- ❑ 1 protractor and 1 compass
- ❑ 2 glue sticks
- ❑ 1 large pink pencil eraser
- ❑ 1 pencil sharpener with catch for shavings
- ❑ 1 box of 8-10 water-based felt-tip markers
- ❑ 4 large boxes of Kleenex
- ❑ 1 pair of scissors
- ❑ 2 highlighters
- ❑ 4 pkg. Post-it Notes (2 medium sized, 2 small)
- ❑ 1 pocket-sized Thesaurus
- ❑ 1 Atlas (Must include World and U.S. maps. I.E. Rand McNally Answer Atlas: The Geography Resource for Students.)
- ❑ USB Key (minimum 512MB memory)
- ❑ 2 "Composition Books" [9-3/4" x 7-1/2"] for Math and Language Arts
- ❑ 1 Emergency kit: In a one-gallon zip lock bag, please include

 - 2 pkgs. soup mix (powdered)

 - 1 light stick (available at Dollar Tree)
 - 1 small container of hand sanitizer
